Dear Advanced Trainee in Endocrinology

We are writing to invite you to register for the **17th ADS John R. Turtle Diabetes Clinical Skills Training Course for Advanced Trainees in Endocrinology**. This course will be held during the 2019 Australian Diabetes Society/Australian Diabetes Educators Association (ADS/ADEA) Australasian Diabetes Congress (ADC) at the International Convention Centre in Sydney on the afternoon of **Friday 23rd August**. The course will be held at the ADC site (inside Meeting Rooms C4.8, C4.9 & C4.10). The course will commence at **1:00pm** for lunch and run until **5:30pm**.

The course will be run by experienced endocrinologists and other diabetes health professionals from across Australia. It is designed to be practical and interactive and will focus on the everyday clinical skills required in the treatment of diabetes by an endocrinology trainee. The course is supported by the Specialist Advisory Committee (SAC) in Endocrinology at the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (RACP).

This year, we are offering the following topics:

- Problem solving with blood glucose data
- Interpreting pump downloads
- Carbohydrate counting
- Exercise and type 1 diabetes
- Managing type 1 and type 2 diabetes in pregnancy
- Lipids
- Fundal photographs
- Pump and CGM data

There is **no registration fee**, although it is preferred that each participant registers for the **2019 ADS/ADEA Australasian Diabetes Congress proper, which is scheduled for 21-23 August**.

To honour Professor John R Turtle in his retirement, the ADS has resolved that the course on an ongoing basis will be named the John R Turtle Diabetes Clinical Skills Training Course for Advanced Trainees in Endocrinology.


Please note the number of places is limited and will be allocated on a '**first-in, first-served**' basis. **Priority will be given to third year trainees who have not yet attended the course.** The training course is **ONLY** open to trainees currently enrolled in adult endocrinology training. **The deadline for registration is Monday 22 July, 2019.** Please note that attendance at ONE John Turtle Diabetes Clinical Skills Course is a compulsory component of advanced training, but you are welcome to attend more than once.

Please check the program as you will need to indicate when completing the online registration form which **stream (1 or 2)** you wish to attend. If your preference is stream 1 then you need to choose between the two options as advised (Workshop A or B, Workshop C or D & Workshop E or F) in each of the three time slots.

The ADS Secretariat will confirm your attendance at the course in writing as soon as possible and will advise you which workshops you have been accepted into following the close of registrations on **Monday 22 July 2019.**


