

RESEARCH PROGRAM 2023 GRANT ROUND

APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

Diabetes Australia is the national organisation supporting all people living with or at risk of diabetes. We work in collaboration with diabetes organisations, people living with diabetes, health professionals, researchers, and the community.

In 2023, Diabetes Australia plans to provide vital funding for diabetes research projects across Australia, including:

- Two \$150,000 Millennium Awards: one for type 1 diabetes and one for type 2 diabetes.
- One \$150,000 Charles Campbell Coghlan OAM Emerging Researcher Award for an early to mid-career researcher.
- An unspecified number of General Grants, up to \$70,000 per grant.

Applications for the 2023 Grant Round are now open. Research projects into any aspect of diabetes management or prevention will be considered. Diabetes Australia encourages applications that focus on:

- Self-monitoring & self-management education and support in diabetes
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and diabetes
- Behavioural and psychological research in diabetes.
